In addition to this class, individual advanced preparation is highly recommended for the Step 2 and Step 3 exam. Topics include: soil-water-plant relationships, advanced hydraulics, electricity, pumps, specialty valves, and irrigation equipment. This course is the standard for the irrigation industry; taught in English units.

Prerequisites: Recommended prerequisites include: basic irrigation design understanding, hydraulics, and soil-plant-water relationships. Excellent prep courses are "Landscape Irrigation Auditor," "Landscape Irrigation Design" and "Understanding Pumps, Controls and Wells."

Math Skills Required: Intermediate math skills are required.
